PROOF OF RESIDENCY FORM
FOR DISSOLUTION PETITIONS

To get a dissolution (divorce) in Florida, either party must have lived in Florida for **at least 6 months before filing the petition**. Residency may be established by a valid Florida's driver's license, Florida identification card, or voter's registration card (issue date of document must be at least 6 months before the date the case is actually filed with the clerk of the circuit court), or the testimony or affidavit of someone other than you or your spouse.

_____ A Florida driver's license, voters registration card, or identification card issued under Fla. Stat. §322.051, which reflects a six month residency prior to filing of the Petition. (**Attached**)

YOU MUST redact (whiteout or blackout) all but the last four digits of your driver license /identification number. Fla. Rule Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin 2.425(a)(4)(C).

If you file an unredacted copy of your driver license, your driver license number will be a public record.

_____ A witness who can testify to your residency in the State of Florida for at least 6 months prior to the filing of the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage. (**Must be present with you at the time of Hearing**)

_____ Affidavit of Corroborating Witness, Form 12.902. The person signing this form must have "personal knowledge" that you have lived in the State of Florida for at least 6 months before the date you filed your petition for dissolution of marriage. (**Filed in the Case**)
